**INSTRUCTIONS FOR LISTING – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY
PLEASE DO NOT WRITE IN SHADED AREAS OF THE LISTING FORM**

This tax listing form MUST be completed and returned to the Brunswick County Tax Office, postmarked no later than January 31, 2009 or you will be charged a late listing penalty in the amount of 10% of the total taxes due on personal property.

NOTE: The Tax Office WILL NOT change your mailing address unless you indicate a change in the area marked “Make Address Corrections Here”.

Section 1 – Make a declaration as to the type of property owned.

Section 2 - If not printed, please provide birthday, telephone number and employer.

Section 3 - Indicate the physical address of your property.

Section 4 – Please indicate if you have made any improvements that are not included in the “assessed value”. If the improvements are under construction, please indicate what percentage was complete as of 1/1/09.

Section 5 – If someone has a mobile home (Single-wide or Double-wide) on your property that does not belong to you, please provide their name and address. Mobile home park owners are required by General Statute 105-316 to provide a list of names of owners of mobile homes in parks.

Section 6 – Single-wide mobile home owners must list every year as personal property. Indicate the brand name, year, width, length and physical address. If pre-printed information in mobile home section is correct, do not list your mobile home again on this form. **DOUBLE-WIDE AND MODULAR HOMES OWNERS:** Double-wide and modular homes must be listed in Section 4 as improvements to real estate. Please provide the brand name and year.

Section 7 – Farmers list all tractors, combines, equipment using additional paper if necessary. 1987 tax law changes exempt certain farm commodities from taxes. You must file a business form to receive the exemption. Please contact the Tax Assessor if you have questions about this exemption or if you think you may qualify.

Section 8 – You are no longer required to list for property taxes vehicles which are currently licensed with the N.C. Division of Motor Vehicles. The tax on these vehicles will be billed by the county after the current registration is renewed or application is made for a new registration. List in this section only unlicensed (untagged) automobiles, trucks, trailers, campers, motorcycles.

Section 9 – List boats and motors that are NOT registered with the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission. If a boat is homemade, indicate that under year and give original cost or value.

Section 10 – List other untagged or unregistered personal property, providing the brand name, year, model and original cost.

North Carolina has created a circuit breaker benefit allowing qualifying elderly and disabled homeowners beginning with Tax Year 2009 to defer a portion of the property taxes assessed on their residences. Qualifying homeowners are those residents that are 65 years old or totally and permanently disabled; have occupied their residence for at least 5 years and earn no more than 150% of the income eligibility limit mentioned below. The application deadline is June 1, 2009.

**PROPERTY TAX RELIEF FOR ELDERLY AND PERMANENTLY DISABLED PERSONS
(BRUNSWICK COUNTY RESIDENTS ONLY)**

North Carolina excludes from property taxes the greater of \$25,000 or 50% of the appraised value of a taxpayer’s primary residence who was at least 65 years of age on 1-1-2009 or is totally and permanently disabled and whose disposable annual income does not exceed \$25,600.
