

# REQUEST FOR BRUNSWICK COUNTY SEWER SYSTEM DATA

At a later date, prior to plan approval, I will provide the County with hard copy design calculations including Hydraulic Grade Line (HGL) profiles and calculations, float levels, proposed design flows, wetwell volumes, wetwell dimensions, pump models, pump curves, key line and station elevations, and pump elevations. Additionally, if I receive the County's electronic sewer model, I will update the model to reflect my proposed improvements and transmit the updated electronic model back to the County for review.

I understand that if calculations indicate that addition of the proposed sewer improvements noted above will cause existing pump stations and sewer lines to function below their required permitted flows, **the Owner/Developer will be responsible for all necessary upgrades to the existing sewer system that are required due to the addition of the proposed development.** In this case, no portion of the project's original proposed improvements shall be approved without the approval and completed agreements necessary for upgrades to the existing system. Existing sewer systems are those that a County representative has both approved **and** signed applicable DENR forms for inclusion under the County permit.

Brunswick County will provide electronic information to those requesting sewer data only in the original format of the data. Electronic files should be verified with hard copies of the same information when available. It is the responsibility of the recipient of the electronic files to verify the electronic files with the hard copies or other relevant means.

Brunswick County created these electronic files for the sole purpose of operating and maintaining its sewer system. Outside use of electronic files by others (engineers, developers, etc.) is done at their own risk. Brunswick County believes that the information contained herein is reliable and generally accurate for the purpose intended. However, since physical conditions may vary and will change over time, Brunswick County makes no performance guarantees, express or implied warranties and assumes no obligation or liability for the reliability or accuracy of the information contained herein; or for the accuracy of the information translated by Brunswick County software for use with end users' software.
