Brunswick Nature Park awarded a Grant, Trail Construction to begin early Dec



The Department of Environment and Natural Resources awarded Brunswick County Parks and Recreation with a 2010 Recreational Trails Program Grant in the amount of \$75,000. This money will be used for the construction of biking and equestrian trails as well as getting the restroom building functioning.

Construction will start on the bike trails in early December.

SOBRA (Southern Off-Road Bicycle Association) has been contracted with the county to oversee, build, and maintain the bike trails.

SOBRA is the largest nonprofit mountain biking organization in the Southeast. Through advocacy, education, and recreational opportunities, SOBRA carries out its mission to promote land access, trail preservation, and new trail development in order to enhance mountain bike touring, racing, fun, and fellowship for all mountain bicyclists in the southeastern United States.
