Rock, Rock and More Rock!

The Brunswick County Landfill recently completed the grinding of the concrete, brick (LCID) that is has been collected at the landfill. The ground material is available to the public at the following cost:

#4 rock	\$12.00 per ton
Rock/soil mix	\$ 7.00 per ton

Also available at the Brunswick County Landfill is mulch. The mulch is created by grinding and sifting the yard debris that is brought in by the public. At this time we have the very fine mulch available and a much coarser mulch available. All mulch is free to residents of Brunswick County. This product is excellent for building up your garden soil and for winterizing plants around your yard.
