Agenda Item: Sample Audit Count and Voter History Audit

Summary

To provide transparency, the sample audit count and voter history audit results are being presented to the board during the canvass meeting prior to election results being finalized.

Sample Audit Count

The sample audit count was conducted on March 7. Two bipartisan teams hand tallied the presidential contest for the Cooperative Extension early voting location and the CB06 Mosquito 1 election day polling place. The hand-to-eye count produced the same results as the machine count.

Voter History

Voter history is currently off by two in the SB04 Southport 2 election day precinct. During the pre-canvass meeting on March 14, the board identified two provisional curbside ballots that were inserted into the tabulator. These two ballots were tallied and will be manually removed from the election day totals at canvass on March 15. Once those votes are removed, the voter history for SB04 Southport 1 will match.

Summary: There has been a request for a second primary for two statewide contests.

- State Auditor (Republican): Jack Clark and Dave Boliek
- Lieutenant Governor (Republican): Hal Weatherman and Jim O'Neill

Early voting plans are due to the State Board of Elections on Monday, March 18. [Numbered Memo 2024-02](#) provides the following guidance on early voting for a second primary.

County boards are not required to use the same early voting plan for the second primary as they did for the first primary. However, the uniform site and hour requirements for even-numbered year elections remain in place for the second primary. This means, at a minimum, the county board office or in lieu of site must be open for early voting during regular business hours on weekdays during the early voting period, as well as from 8:00 a.m. to 3 p.m. on the last Saturday of early voting. If the county board office is open only regular business hours, the uniform dates and hours requirements do not apply to that location. If the county board office or in lieu of site is open beyond regular business hours, the uniform dates and hours requirements described below apply to that location.

Board Action: Determine an early voting plan for the second primary.
