



# VOTER REGISTRATION

To register to vote in North Carolina, you must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be at least 18 years old
- Youth age 16 and 17 may pre-register to vote
- Live in the county where you are registering
- Not be serving a felony sentence, any period of probation, post-release supervision, or parole.

First time registrants or voters who need to make updates can do so:

- In-person at the Board of Elections office or DMV
- Online through the DMV portal - voter must have a valid NC Drivers License or NC state issued ID card
- Printed form can be downloaded from the state or county website or obtained at voter registration drives, libraries, high schools and public assistance agencies
- New registrants can mail form or drop off in person at Board of Elections office
- Registered voters with updates can mail, email or fax form, or drop off form in person at Board of Elections office

Voter Registration Card: sent to an applicant to acknowledge receipt of the application/update form and to verify the information contained on the form

- Voters should check that voter information is correct on card
- Errors or voter changes can be corrected on right side of card
- Card should be stamped and mailed *if* changes are made
- If card is correct, voter keeps for their records

## Voter Status and Important Terms:

### ACTIVE (registered)

Registration is confirmed at the listed address and voter is eligible to vote.

### INACTIVE (registered)

Indicates that the county board of elections has not been able to verify by mail the address in the voter's record. Voter is eligible to vote, but will need to verify or update their address.

### MAIL VERIFICATION

Confirms voters mailing address. Mailings are not forwarded, but returned to us undeliverable. We attempt two first class mailings to the address the voter provides. If notified of a different address by the post office, a confirmation card is sent to the voter that must be signed and returned within 30 days to keep the voter's record active.

### DENIED (not registered)

An application for original registration is not approved by the county board, or is not verified by the required mailings.

### REMOVED (not registered)

Removed status indicates that an active or inactive voter has been removed from the registration rolls. Reasons for removal include death, felony conviction, move, signed cancellation statement by voter, and failure to respond to list maintenance mailings. Removed voters must re-register to be eligible to vote.

### INCOMPLETE (not registered)

Voter's registration is missing required information. Voter is mailed a letter with instructions on how to complete their registration. Once returned to our office and mail verification is complete, the voter is registered as active.
