**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF A SURPLUS
GRIZZLY MOSQUITO SPRAYER TO THE TOWN OF CAROLINA SHORES**

WHEREAS, a Grizzly Mosquito Sprayer (Serial #102305) belonging to Vector Control of Brunswick County is no longer needed because the County has deemed the mosquito sprayer surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Carolina Shores is establishing mosquito control services and can utilize such a sprayer; and

WHEREAS, Brunswick County is authorized to donate personal property to other governmental units pursuant to the terms of N.C.G.S. § 160A-280; and

WHEREAS, Brunswick County desires to donate said mosquito sprayer to the Town of Carolina Shores for its use in its mosquito control program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Brunswick County Board of Commissioners:

1. That the aforementioned Grizzly Mosquito Sprayer be declared surplus; and
2. That Brunswick County Vector Control be authorized to donate the surplus personal property to the Town of Carolina Shores without consideration.
