

HEALTH EDUCATION, PROMOTION, AND OUTREACH SERVICES

We provide public information concerning specific health related topics; and we plan and participate in community health fairs, presentations, and events.

VITAL RECORDS

The Health Services Director is responsible for the registration of all births and deaths occurring in Brunswick County, as well as the issuance of burial-transit permits and disinterment/reinterment permits.

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

Serves to protect the community by:

- Educating the public on environmental health issues
- Assessing environmental and community health concerns
- Preventing the spread of disease and promoting personal safety
- Through monitoring and surveillance, staff ensures compliance with state, local, and environmental health laws



LABORATORY SERVICES

Provides services for Health Services clinics and testing offered by other community providers. Fees will vary.

DIABETES EDUCATION

An ADA-recognized education program offering individual and group self-management skills including self-monitoring, medication, and nutritional education. Referrals are accepted from your personal health care provider.



Some services are offered on sliding scale fee that is based on your household size and income. We accept all major insurances.

All services, including WIC, are open to all eligible persons regardless of race, color, sex, national origin, age or disability.

Interpreters are available to assist during clinic visits.

PROGRAMS AND CLINICS

GENERAL CLINIC

Offers a wide range of health services including childhood immunizations from birth to 18 years of age, inspection for head lice with treatment available, pregnancy testing, and tuberculosis screening. Adult immunizations are available. No appointment is needed for these services.

COMMUNICABLE DISEASE

Communicable Disease Clinic is for a variety of basic health services including confidential STD testing, STD treatment, and communicable disease testing. Tuberculosis treatment is also available.

BREAST & CERVICAL CANCER CONTROL PROGRAM (BCCCP)

The North Carolina Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program (NC BCCCP) provides free or low-cost mammograms and cervical cancer screenings (Pap test) and follow-up to eligible women in North Carolina.



IMMUNIZATION CLINIC

Offering all CDC-recommended immunizations for children, college-bound students, and adults. Providing flu shots for all ages as well as outreach clinics for flu vaccines.

PEDIATRIC PRIMARY CARE

The Pediatric Clinic offers well and sick care to children, including kindergarten and sports physicals, and childhood immunizations.



MATERNITY CLINIC

Gives newborns a healthy start in life by providing expectant moms with early and regular pre-natal care throughout their pregnancy. All pregnant women who are Brunswick County residents are eligible.

WOMEN'S HEALTH SERVICES

We provide family planning services for men and women to assist in planning and/or preventing pregnancy and maternity clinics to provide prenatal care to all Brunswick County residents. Pregnancy testing is available. Teenagers do not need parental consent for treatment.

CARE COORDINATION FOR CHILDREN & PREGNANCY CARE MANAGEMENT

Care Managers provide counseling and case management to at-risk, Medicaid-eligible pregnant women to ensure healthy babies are born.

POSTPARTUM & NEWBORN HOME VISITS

A newborn and postpartum assessment is offered within two weeks after birth. This includes assessment of vital signs, weight, reflexes, feeding, and bonding between newborn and mother. This service is provided by referral.

WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN (WIC)

The WIC program is a supplemental nutrition program that provides food, nutrition education and breastfeeding support to income-eligible women who are pregnant, have recently given birth, are breastfeeding, as well as infants and children up to five years of age.
