


Pulling Voter Registration Data from the State



1. Click on the file for the data you want, a zip folder will load to the bottom of the screen.



2. Click on the zip folder to open it, click 'Extract All'. Select a location for the file to be saved. The text file will be saved in that location.
3. Open an excel spreadsheet. Click 'File' then 'Open'. Navigate to the location of the file and change the file type to All Files. Choose the ncvoter file.



To get the data in excel format, select delimited, next, comma (leave tab checked), next, finish. The data will populate.

4. Click 'File', 'Save As' to save the file as an excel spreadsheet by changing the file type to excel workbook (.xlsx).
5. Press ctrl+t to turn the data into a table. Once this is done you can select data that you want to omit by using the arrow in the header rows. For example, if you only want to see active and inactive voters, change the selection in status_cd to A and I only.

*There are columns for all possible jurisdictions (county commissioner, NC House district, municipality, etc).
