Never pour grease down the drain after you have cooked. It creates problems down the line for everyone.



Pour leftover grease into a disposal container and place into trash can.



When grease enters the sewer system, it turns into a solid creating a blockage.



When the lines get clogged with grease, it won't allow wastewater to flow, therefore an overflow occurs.

It cost time and money (your money) to maintain and clean up sewer spills...



Here are a few helpful hints to keep the pipes flowing...

- Never flush disposable wipes down the toilet-even if they are advertised as flushable
- Never put grease down the sink, in the toilet, or down a floor drain
- Always scrape pots, pans, and dishes clean in the trash can before washing them in the sink or placing them in dishwasher
