

**Brunswick County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council
June 18, 2020 Meeting Minutes**

I. CALL TO ORDER:

Warren Mortley reported that for the month of May Providence Home had no kids. They are upgrading their security system, power washed the house and purchased laptops. They had a meeting on June 29 with Marsha Rogge and her staff.

Lois Jackson reported that in May Restitution had no programs. They are preparing packets for the kids to do at home.

4. GGC & STEP:

Erin Ditta reported that in May GGC had a beginning count of 1, 3 admission, 3 completions for an ending count of 1. They met with Marsha Rogge. The parents liked the virtual meetings and they had higher attendance. They would attempt online on a case by case basis depending on fidelity.

5. Coastal ART:

Kristina Clemmons reported they closed 24 cases in May. They are finished for the year.
