Burn Ban Issued for Brunswick County

As of noon today Monday, May 24, 2021, a burn ban has been issued for the unincorporated areas within Brunswick County.

Fire Marshal Andrew Thompson wants to remind citizens that all burning within 100 feet of any structure is banned within the unincorporated areas of Brunswick County. The burning ban does not apply to charcoal or gas grills provided fire safety precautions are taken. An unincorporated area is an area not within a city's or town's limits.

According to US Drought Monitor for North Carolina Brunswick County is experiencing moderate drought conditions in addition to a high fire danger index rating from the North Carolina Forest Service. The current and future weather forecast models indicate conditions that are not favorable to open burning. If you're located in either a city or town, please contact your local municipal official related to the burn ban.
